GROUP SIZE: Trips costs are based on optimum group sizes. If we don't get the required number of people (5 for all trips), you will be notified as soon as possible and offered the choice of:
 a) A full refund of the money you have paid.

- b) A transfer to another date at no cost to you.
- c) Paying a surcharge.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Please Read Carefully Before Signing

In consideration of MAT accepting my application for and me being permitted to go on the adventure trip and engage in recreational activities including, but not limited to, cycling, mountain biking and skiing which may involve a significant risk of physical harm, I agree to this release of claims, waiver of liability and assumption of risk.

I am aware that cycling, mountain biking and skiing (the recreational activities) are dangerous recreational activities which may involve, in addition to usual and inherent risks, personal injury, obvious risk, danger to myself, the possibility of injury and harm and physical exertion for which I may not be prepared, remoteness to normal medical service, weather extremes subject to sudden and unexpected change and evacuation difficulties if I am disabled.

I accept all of the inherent and obvious risks of the recreational activities and of the proposed adventure trip and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting there from. I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of adventure travel is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by travel and activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home or work and that these inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment and excitement being a reason for my participation.

I waive any and all claims I may now and in the future have against and release from all liability and agree not to sue MAT and its officers, employees, guides, representatives (collectively its staff) for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained by me as a result of my participation in any of the recreational activities or the

adventure trip with MAT, due to any cause whatsoever, including without any limitation, negligence on the part of MAT and its staff.

I agree that if I suffer injury or illness, MAT can at my cost arrange medical treatment and emergency evacuation services as MAT deem essential for my safety.

In entering into this agreement, I am not relying on any oral, written or visual representations or statements by MAT or its staff or any other inducement or coercion to go on the adventure trip, hence only of my own free will.

I confirm that I am an age of legal consent (that is 18 years or older in Australia) and that I have read and understand this agreement, prior to signing it and agree that this agreement will be binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and successors. I agree that this agreement shall be governed in all respects by and interpreted in accordance with the law of the State of New South Wales.

I further acknowledge that in consideration of MAT consenting to me participating in an adventure trip with MAT, I will take out a policy of travel insurance covering me for the period of the trip.

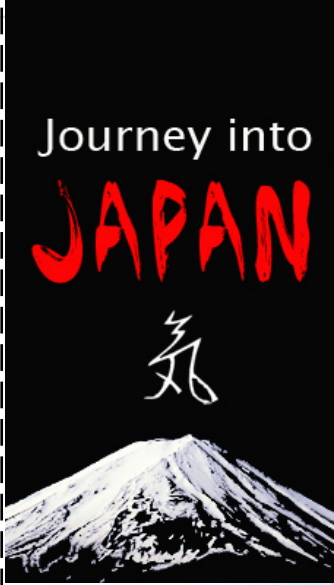
